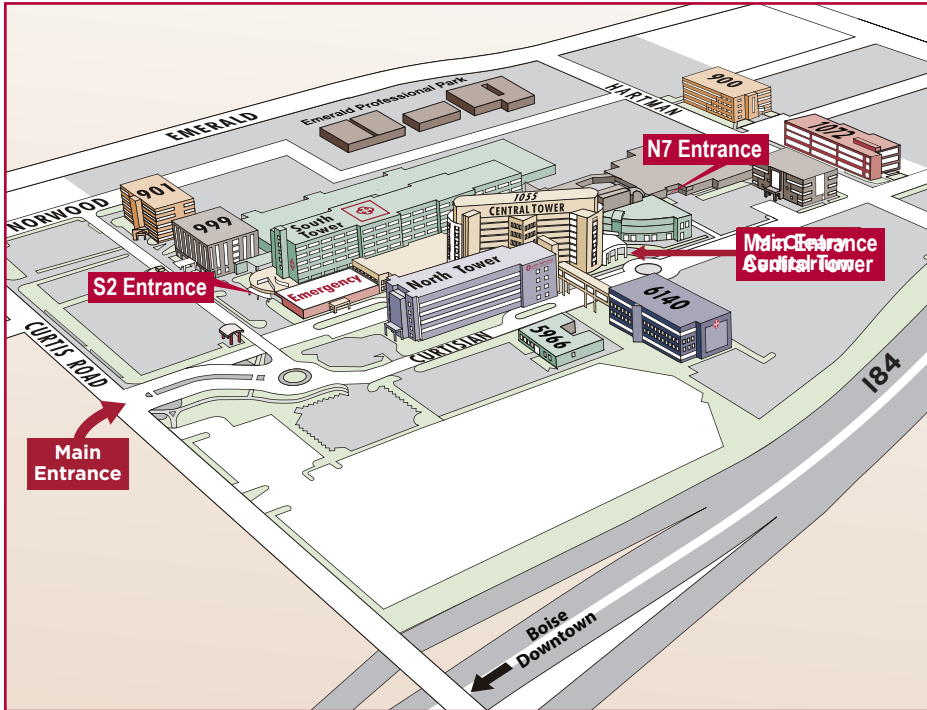


Saint Alphonus Regional Medical Center Surgery and Procedure Instructions



Main Operating Room

(Monday - Friday):

Enter at the Main Entrance (Central Tower near the roundabout) and check in at registration desk. They will direct you to the 2nd floor surgery waiting room where you will follow signage for additional instructions.

Main Operating Room

(Saturday/Sunday):

Enter at the S2 entrance, which faces Curtis Road. Connect with the attendant, and he or she will direct you to the 2nd floor surgery waiting room.

Day Surgery

(Monday - Friday):

Enter at the N7 entrance off Curtisian Avenue and check in at the registration desk.

Things to Know for Your Surgery or Procedure:

1. Wear a clean mask to the hospital. If you, or your guests do not have one, one will be provided when you arrive.

3. If no one is available at the Waiting Room Desk, use the desk phone and dial 72179 or 76604 to speak with a nurse.
4. Prior to being sent home, your driver/support person will be contacted and given instructions on when and where to pick you up.
5. Discharge instructions will be given to your family or friend, after you have been discharged.
