

LUNG SCREENING PROGRAM

CMS now covers patients who meet certain criteria/risk factors to receive annual low-dose CT exams.

Option 1:

Patients who meet the criteria to be enrolled in the lung screening program can be sent to the Saint Alphonsus Lung Screening Clinic.

Eligibility

- Patient must be between 55-77 years of age.
- Are currently a smoker or have quit smoking within the last 15 years.
- Has at least a 30+ pack-year smoking history (packs/day x total years smoked =pack per year).
- Smoking must be related to cigarettes only (no cigars, vaping, e-cigs).
- Patient is currently asymptomatic for lung cancer.

CT HEAD WITHOUT CONTRAST

- Acute headache
- Suspected intracranial hemorrhage
- Acute neurological changes
- Hydrocephalus
- Seizure if new onset and patient is unstable




